

Tips to Keep Your Dog Safe and Secure...

- ✓ Have your dog microchipped.
- ✓ Keep the microchip contact information accurate. Update all information if you move or change phone numbers.
- ✓ Make sure your dog wears a collar with current contact information.
- ✓ Neuter or spay your dog. Intact animals are more likely to stray. And, pets may be stolen with the intent to breed. Neutering and spaying also reduces overpopulation.
- ✓ Keep your dog contained either in a fence or a kennel. Lock the fence or kennel to prevent anyone from letting your dog out or stealing your dog. Tethered dogs face many risks such as getting tangled or choked, attacked by other animals with less ability to defend themselves, and injury or illness as a result of exposure and theft.
- ✓ Keep current photos of your dog on hand, in the event that you need the images to make and post files.
- ✓ Never leave your dog unattended in a car. This leaves them susceptible to heat or cold exposure as well as theft.
- ✓ Exercise, play with and love your dog! A well-exercised dog is less likely to get bored, wander or run away.
